FOUL LANGUAGE & SLEDGING POLICY

Cromer Kingfishers JRLFC has a zero tolerance policy towards foul language and sledging by players, Coaches and helpers. Coaches & Mangers are required to address such unacceptable action immediately if it occurs before, during & after training also on game day.

If audible swearing occurs, (which is sufficient to be heard or has the potential to cause offence to any player, official or spectator), the Coach or Manger will immediately penalise and remove the offending player from the field for a period of time or send the player home

Following any player being reported, a formal caution will be issued to the player.

The Coach or Manger is required to record and report the offence to the Executive Committee . If the player keeps offending at training or game days the player must be sent from training or the field and will have to appear before a panel of 2 committee members which may result incurring an (2) game suspension by the Cromer Kingfishers executive committee

This policy has been put in place so to teach our younger players that there is no need for bad language & sledging in our club by any Cromer Kingfisher players. The Club is obliged to act on and penalise players for continual breaches of the rules, bad sporting behaviour or any other action which is not in the spirit the Cromer Kingfishers JRLFC & of the game itself.
